The Treasurer reported on the checkbook balance. Using the new insurance company has provided us with 2 million dollars worth of insurance coverage.

The Financial Secretary turned in money from membership renewals consisting of 15 regular, 4 spousal, 1 retired for a total of 20 members for 2007 with 10 new members for the month of January. A motion was made and carried to file for future audit. In February there was one member for the 2006-year for a total of 392 members. As of April 2 there are 349 members for 2007.

CORRESPONDENCE:

BILLS: were tabled for this month.

COMMITTEE REPORT:

Claybird – Turned in money for ammo, targets and components. During the last month 10 rounds were non-members. The summer skeet league will start in May. The trap league on Sunday will also start in May. April 15th will be the 100 bird shoot with the winter league banquet to follow.

Pistol –The Mass. State All League shoot off will be held May 12th.

Archery –There is 8 – 10 people attending the adult education program each week. Building supplies were provided to continue repairs on the facility.

Membership – We have 10 new members this month. The unpaid dues reminder notices were sent out and were very successful. We presently have 27 more members now than we had last year. Our profit and loss statements indicate we need 43 new members to cover expenses.

Building – The indoor lead removal is completed. We split the income from the lead after expenses. A new timer switch for the heat in the indoor range has been put in.

Chief Range Officer – New badges are needed.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Peter P. will speak to the new member regarding safety rules.

2. The land sale process is moving along well.
3. 690 lbs of lead was retrieved from the indoor range. The club received payment.
4. The safety wall between the pistol and rifle range is completed.
5. A police report was filed in regards to the damage to the signs on the property.
6. Clear title for the land has been resolved.
7. The Boy scouts will be at the club on April 16th for an archery instruction program with Arthur J.

NEW BUSINESS:

4. A motion was made and carried that five new range officer badges may be purchased.
5. The club runs in the red each year as seen from profit and loss statements.
6. Each discipline must come up with some way to generate revenue.
