The Secretary's report for May was accepted as read.

The Treasurer's report for May was tabled.

The Financial Secretary turned in money from memberships consisting of 1 renewal for 2010, 1 Spousal and 11 new members in April for a total of 13 members with the purchase of 2 indoor range cards. There are a total of 416 members for 2010. There were 377 members this time last year. There are 39 more renewals and new members this year than last year. A motion was made and carried to file for future audit.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Claybird – Turned in money. There were 276 skeet and 60 trap rounds shot last month. 10 boxes of ammo were sold and money was collected from component sales. Summer Skeet League has started.

Pistol – All is going well. Money turned in from the May 23rd 2700 match. There were 15 shooters. The State Regional 2700 Match will be held Sunday June 13th. There are 20 pre-registered competitors.

Rifle – The new target material is lasting twice as long as the old material. The eyebrows needed to be supported so heavy wire and more lag bolts were installed for added support.

Building & Grounds – The tractors have had maintenance and service. New blades were applied and a second set of blades is needed for each tractor. The rifle range roof was completed with a 24 ft. extension added to allow for a storage room.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Barry spoke with John regarding the land sale status, picked up the new purchase and sales agreement and John wanted to make word changes. If he accepts and the committee agrees then it will be signed at the lawyers in a week.
2. Dave checked on a security system, which would consist of 2 gates, 1 card controlled and one manual. The individual cards would record who comes in the stat room, pistol range and main door. There is a possibility there will be wireless control for the pistol range card controls.
3. A poster needs to go up advertising the Cumberland Beagle and Angle Tree skeet competition on July 24, 2010.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. The following 11 people applied for membership, Peter S, James B, Stephen P, Shane B, Eduardo V, John V, Bruce S, Terri M, Joseph H, Ralph P, Michael P. A motion was made and carried to accept the new members as read.
2. A motion was made and carried that Butch P be added to the Treasures Bond, as the Assistant Treasurer, to allow checks and money to be deposited the next day after each Board meeting which will continue until the end of the year and be added to this year's standing rules.
3. It is a recommendation that the amounts of the prorated dues for next year be changed, with June, July & August be \$90.00, September be \$65.00 and October, November & December change to the imitation fee only with no membership fee due.
4. A motion was made and carried the rifle range storage shed be completed with doors and electricity at a cost of \$2,500.00.

NEW BUSINESS Con't:

5. The stairs on the rifle range need to be repaired.
6. Of the money received from John D, there is about \$13,000.00 remaining.
7. Ted's classes will be held June 22nd, 24th, and 27th.
8. 1 metal eyebrow will be donated to Cumberland Beagle for their pistol range.
9. Sunday June 13th the skeet field and rifle range will be shut down for the Regional competition.
10. The Pistol Committee expense report for the purchase of the Regional 2700 scorecards was submitted.
11. The Income and Expense report for the May 2700 match was turned in.
